

Case Study – Asbestos Consultancy



International Food Production Company

Approximate project value

£20,000 (to date as of February 2013)

Project overview

Asbestos Consultancy, Surveying and Air Monitoring within an international food production organisation located within the Midlands. We were appointed to provide advice, support and assistance to implement an asbestos management plan, following the identification of asbestos containing materials in poor condition during the routine re-inspection of known asbestos containing materials within the premises.

Duration

August 2012 – present , this contract is still ongoing

The problem

ACMs in poor condition were identified during the routine re-inspection in relation to the client's ongoing asbestos management. The client wished to maintain the occupancy of the affected areas, and effectively the continued operation of the factory, and as such an action plan was required to be implemented to facilitate this.

What we did

We carried out additional surveying and sampling exercises in order to fully ascertain the scope of the affected areas. All sampling and testing was undertaken in our own UKAS accredited laboratory. Once the testing and sampling was complete, we made recommendations in relation to the required action plan. Air monitoring was undertaken on a regular basis to confirm the airborne fibre levels within the affected areas. We deployed a dedicated project manager to the works, who liaised closely with the client, in order to keep any disruption and concerns of the site personnel to a minimum.

What we achieved

- We deployed a survey team/analyst to site to undertake sampling and surveys
- We delivered the results from this work within 24 hours, while still maintaining service delivery to other clients.
- We were subsequently appointed to act as part of the project team in relation to the ongoing management and removal of the ACMs identified and this project is due to start imminently.
- We have also been appointed to undertake a series of Asbestos Awareness Training sessions.
