Course Summary: This training, based on the BOHS P405 Management of Asbestos Building course, will provide you with the practical knowledge and skills to be able to manage asbestos in properties, including the specifying and commissioning of surveys, interpretation of survey results and advice and the management of a asbestos removal projects.

The course is aimed at: Maintenance managers responsible for commissioning maintenance or decent homes works. Managers specifically responsible for the management of asbestos, ensuring compliance and advising the board.

- Understanding of the legal obligations upon social landlords in relation to the Control of Asbestos Regulations, including the 2012 revisions and wider health and safety law, pertaining to asbestos.

 - Understand the role of the analyst in removal works and correctly specify the monitoring required to safeguard your tenants.
